How UK Exams are assessed:

All UK qualifications are acceptable (eg: GCSE, A-Level, NVQ, VCE and AVCE). Applicants can present combinations of these awards to meet the minimum entry requirements for IT Sligo.

Level 7 (Ordinary Bachelor Degree)

- Applicants must present a minimum of 3 recognised subjects at A-Level/AS-Level
- In addition, applicants must hold at GCSE Mathematics and English

Level 8 (Honours Bachelor Degree)

- Applicants must present a minimum of 3 recognised subjects at A-Level/AS-Level
- At least 2 of these subjects must be at A-Level, at Grade C or better
- In addition applicants must hold GCSE (Grade A, B, or C in Mathematics and English)

Basis for Computation of Points:

- The Maximum number of points that can be scored by any candidate presenting school leaving examinations is 600
- A maximum of 4 A-Levels will be counted when calculating points.
- Only A-Levels obtained at one sitting will be counted
- 1 A-Level is deemed equivalent to 1.5 x 1 Leaving Certificate Higher subject
- Each AS-Level subject is equivalent to half of an A-Level
- GCSE achievement can be used to satisfy matriculation requirements but will not be awarded any points

Applicants with BTEC and NVQ qualifications:

While studying at IT Sligo, you will advance through a series of internationally recognised qualifications. All Northern Ireland/UK equivalencies to our qualifications are shown in the accompanying table:
