Course Description

This course will prepare participants with the knowledge, skills and competencies required for success in management of water and wastewater services.

In Stage 1, the focus is on developing a greater understanding and the management of people and organisations, project planning and implementation, and the legal and planning framework relevant to the water sector in Ireland.

In Stage 2, the focus is on water sector specific specialist topics on contracts and procurement, the integration of management systems, data analytics and information management, strategic management, standard and innovative processes and technologies and asset management and resilience.

Stage 3 involves the completion of a Dissertation on a specialist research topic of your choice relating to a relevant aspect of water, wastewater or a management issue.
